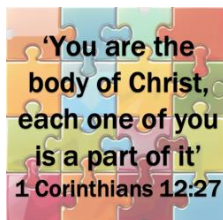

Needed someone who is methodical and good with figures to independently examine our yearly accounts...do you know anyone who might like to give some time to do this for us?



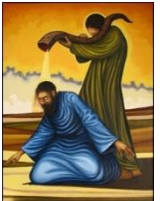
